Subject: **2016 Judicial Campaign Ethics Training and Guidance**

Mandatory Training*

All individuals who are seeking state-paid elective judicial office must complete a judicial campaign ethics training program. 22 NYCRR 100.5(A)(4)(f); 100.6(A); NY Rules of Professional Conduct, Rule 8.2(b). Only candidates for town or village justice are exempt.

As in prior years, the training program for 2016 will be available for viewing on-line.

- ▶ Deadline: 30 days after the date of nomination.
 - ▶ Running in a primary? The deadline to complete the training is 30 days after filing a designating petition with the Board of Elections.
- ▶ The training **may** be completed before the date of nomination.
- ▶ Training taken in one election cycle **does not** “carry over” into subsequent years.
